Who is The Fauquier Bank?

The Fauquier Bank was founded in 1902 and is headquartered in Warrenton, VA. They have 11 branches from Warrenton/Fauquier County to Prince William County and Manassas.

Why did VNB and TFB merge?

This merger will create a premier Virginia financial institution with greater scale, operating leverage and complementary business lines. The combined company will operate under the Virginia National Bank brand and will be able to serve larger clients in its core Virginia markets of Charlottesville, Warrenton, Winchester and the counties of Albemarle, Fauquier, Frederick and Prince William, and expand current markets in Richmond and Northern Virginia.

What will happen to employees?

As the two banks do not have any market area overlap, we intend to respectfully and thoughtfully integrate our employees as one company.

What does this mean to VNB customers?
